Cemetery Gardening Angels offer a variety of services for cemetery plots of deceased family members.

Services Include:

- Design, planting and maintenance of loved ones plots
- Personal consultation before planting
- Digital photos sent via email
- Supply of top soil and mulch
- Supply and planting of all flowers and shrubs
- Fertilize plants throughout the season
- Watering, weeding, pruning and trimming throughout the entire season
- Spring and fall clean-up of flower beds

Price quoted is based on yearly season

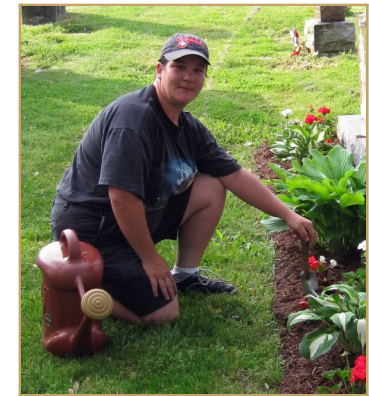
